Bartender and John Pugmire of Swaffham in the said County Surveyor Esquire and appointed us and by an Act of parliament
passed in the forty eighth year of the Reign of his present Majesty King George the Second Entituled "An Act for amending Lands in the Parish of
Boddam in the County of Norfolk made up and by virtue of the powers and authority given us by virtue of the said Act, and by a certain
other Act of parliament made and passed in the forty first year of the Reign of his present Majesty King George the Second "An Act for consolidating in one Athelstan
Parish usually inserted in acts of Assumption and for facilitating the mode of dividing the several parts usually required in the passing of
such Acts and also by a certain other Act of Parliament passed in the forty ninth year of the Reign of his said Majesty Entituled "An Act to amend
an Act passed in the forty eighth year of his present Majesty for amending Lands in the Parish of Boddam in the County of Norfolk"

First we the said Commissioners do declare that in and before to all the return of every return that in pursuance of the said mentioned Act shall be made to the Directors of the said lands and grounds in the said parish of Boddam and the several other parts of the same by reason of the Survey of the said lands and grounds made by the said Surveyor Esquire and his assistants and by virtue of the said Act at least before every return being made to the said Directors by the said Surveyor Esquire and his assistants and by virtue of the said Act passed in the forty first year of his said Majesty King George the Second to be by us respectively taken and subscribed
And we do hereby further certify that we have inquired into the boundaries of the said parish of Boddam and that such boundaries
are marked and laid down upon the map or plan of the said parish of Boddam hereto annexed And we do hereby further certify and declare that the said map and boundaries
and plan of all the abovesaid Cottages orchards gardens homesteads lands and grounds within the said parish of Boddam have been made and reduced into writing by Charles Martineau of
Soll in the said County of Norfolk the Surveyor appointed by us and that the number of acres and dimensions of an acre in Statute measure contained in all the said lands and grounds
and of each and every proprietor's distinct property in the same respectively at the time of such survey and measurement are herein set forth and specified And that the said Charles
Martineau hath verified such survey measurement and plan upon the said Cottages orchards gardens homesteads lands and grounds in Boddam aforesaid And that he also fully informed ourselves of all the rights and interests of the several
parties interested in the premises and all other Owners and tenants touching or concerning the Division and Distribution of the said lands and gardens and the Woods and plantations there
after contained And we do hereby certify that the said lands and grounds in Boddam aforesaid containe in the said year and the several publick and private roads therein after set forth
and apportioned according to the said survey and measurement contain together by Statute measure one thousand six hundred and thirty three acres two rods and fourteen perches and
that we have according to the directions of the said Act of parliament assigned set out and allotted the same in manner herein after mentioned And we the said Commissioners in pursuance
of the power and authority vested in us by the said Act of Parliament respectively and according to the directions therin by us to our several
agents delivered and executed by us among set out and allot all and singular the whole year Lands half year or short Lands so called Common Waste Lands and Woods
Grounds in Boddam aforesaid save and except the said fourth part in such manner and subject to such rules orders directions and provisions as are in and by the said Act respectively and
thus our award made established and pincers containing the same (that is to say) on the first place we do hereby set out and appoint the several publick carriage Roads and the four
roads or highways herein after described (that is to say) First One publick carriage road beginning at or near the south east corner of the allotment hereby made to William Avery and
proceeding from thence nearly in a west direction and on the north side of the first allotment hereby made to John Tanton alias Esquire to the south east corner of the second allotment
Second made to John Tanton alias Esquire and Elizabeth his wife and from thence nearly in the same direction and in its present course to the south east corner of the third allotment hereby made to
the said John Tanton alias Esquire and from thence nearly in the same direction and on the north side of the allotment last mentioned to the south west corner thereof where it entereth the parish of Boddam
in the said County of Norfolk which road is called cross road second. One other publick carriage road beginning at the east end of the publick carriage road first described and proceeding from thence
nearly in a south east and east direction and in its present course to the south corner of the first allotment hereby made to John Tully and
the south east side of the allotment last mentioned to the north east corner thereof where it entereth the parish of West Boddam in the said County of Norfolk which publick carriage road lastly
described is called Crows road Third one other publick carriage road beginning at the east end of the publick carriage road first described and proceeding from thence nearly in a west direction
and in its present course to the south west corner of the fourth allotment hereby made to the said John Tanton alias Esquire and Elizabeth his wife and from thence nearly in a north direction and on the
west side of the allotment last mentioned to the north west corner thereof where it entereth the parish of Calbourne in the said Co. of Suffolk which publick carriage road lastly described is called Walbers
road Fourth one other publick carriage road beginning at the publick carriage road lastly described at the north west corner thereof and from thence made to the said John Tanton alias
Esquire and Elizabeth his wife and proceeding from thence nearly in a south direction and on the west side of the allotment last mentioned to the south west corner thereof where it entereth the publick
carriage road last described which publick carriage road lastly described is called cross road Fifth one other publick carriage road beginning at the east end of the publick carriage road first
described and proceeding from thence nearly in east and south east direction and in its present course to the north side of a hedge or dwelling house and from thence
where it entereth the said parish of West Boddam which publick carriage road lastly described is called Boddam road Sixth One other publick carriage road branching out of the publick carriage road
lastly described at the north west corner of the first allotment made to John Tully and proceeding from thence nearly in a south direction and in its present course to the north
east corner of the second allotment hereby made to the said John Tully and from thence nearly in a south direction and on the east side
of the allotment last mentioned to the south east corner thereof where it entereth the parish of Calbourne in the said County of Norfolk and from thence nearly in a south direction and on the east side
of the allotment last mentioned to the south east corner thereof where it entereth the parish of West Boddam and from thence nearly in a south west direction and in its present course to the south west corner of the said allotment
where it entereth the parish of Boddam in the said County of Norfolk which publick carriage road lastly described is called Boddam road Seventh one other publick carriage road branching out of the publick
carriage road lastly described at the north east corner of the first allotment hereby made to the said John Tully and from thence nearly in a west direction and in its present course to the south east corner of the said allotment
where it entereth the parish of Boddam in the said County of Norfolk which publick carriage road lastly described is called Boddam road Eighth one other publick carriage road branching out of the publick carriage road
lastly described at the north west corner of the first allotment hereby made to John Tully and proceeding from thence nearly in a south direction and on the west side of the said allotment to the south west corner thereof
where it entereth the parish of Boddam in the said County of Norfolk which publick carriage road lastly described is called Boddam road Ninth one other publick carriage
