The Committee:

The village hall committee are all volunteers. We look after the day to day running of the hall, and we organise regular events such as movie night and the community café as well as special events. We are Chair Pat Spurgeon, Treasurer Rachel Spurgeon, Secretary Nigel Rawlings, also Helen Bruford, Gill Matthams, Carolyn Rawlings, Martyn Waring and Ann Waring.

Finances & Solar Panel project:

The village hall made a loss for the financial years 2022 and 2023. Costs have been increasing significantly, with electricity well over 50% of the hall running costs. Bookings and donations dropped during COVID; they are slowly picking up again but are not sufficient to cover the increased costs.

Solar panels were identified by the committee as the best solution to reduce electricity costs for the long term. There were 2 options to be considered:

1. Solar panels only, at a cost of about £11,500.

2. Solar panels plus battery pack, at a cost of about £16,500. Option 2 was chosen because the inclusion of the battery pack offered far greater savings both environmentally and financially. We expect to be able to nearly halve the electricity costs and prevent 2949kg of CO2 from entering the atmosphere, the equivalent of planting 3 trees with 100-year life.

We are now applying for grants and running a series of special community events to raise funds for the Solar Panel project.
